Make sure that the Mouse Keys are turned on. (System Preferences --> Universal Access --> Mouse & Trackpad --> Mouse Keys)

Speech Command	What it does
Hold Mouse Button	This holds the mouse button down until the release mouse button command is executed
Mouse Click	Clicks the mouse button
Mouse Double Click	Double-clicks the mouse button
Mouse Down	Moves the mouse pointer down one time.
Mouse Down [Five, Ten, Twenty Five, Fifty, One Hundred, Two Hundred Fifty, Five Hundred, One Thousands]	Moves the mouse pointer down 5, 10, 25, 50, 100, 250, 500, 1000 times
Mouse Left	Moves the mouse pointer to the left one time
Mouse Left [Five, Ten, Twenty Five, Fifty, One Hundred, Two Hundred Fifty, Five Hundred, One Thousands]	Moves the mouse pointer to the left 5, 10, 25, 50, 100, 250, 500, 1000 times
Mouse Right	Moves the mouse pointer to the right one time
Mouse Right [Five, Ten, Twenty Five, Fifty, One Hundred, Two Hundred Fifty, Five Hundred, One Thousands]	Moves the mouse pointer to the right 5, 10, 25, 50, 100, 250, 500, 1000 times
Mouse Up	Moves the mouse pointer up one time

Mouse Up [Five, Ten, Twenty Five, Fifty, One Hundred, Two Hundred Fifty, Five Hundred, One Thousands]	Moves the mouse pointer up 5, 10, 25, 50, 100, 250, 500, 1000 times
Release Mouse Hold	Releases the mouse button from being held down
Right Mouse Click	Right-clicks (control clicks) the mouse *NOTE: On a few computers this command had trouble executing. The user may have to say the command a few times to get it to execute
Shift Mouse Click	Shift-clicks the mouse button
